Students are to keep a summer journal. They are to write ten entries. Each entry must be two paragraphs. Each paragraph needs to have at least five sentences. The students should be adding details and writing descriptive stories. They should be answering the questions; How, Who, Where, When, Why, and What? The topics have already been assigned to the students. A notebook was provided to each student. Your child is encouraged to keep writing during the
