Written Book Report Format and Rubric

Content: 5 paragraphs (50 Points) Each paragraph is worth 10 points.

- Paragraph 1: Author, Setting, Time
- Paragraph 2: Description of the MAIN character
- Paragraph 3: Plot (problem/solution faced by the main character)
- Paragraph 4: Theme/ Moral (underlying idea/lesson learned)
- Paragraph 5: Opinion and Recommendation

Mechanics: (30 Points- 10points for each bullet below)

- Spelling
- Punctuation/Capitalization
- Grammar/Usage

Form: (20 Points for this section)

- Readability/Legibility (10 points)
- Neatness (5 points)
- Written in cursive (5points)
